COUNT 1:

On or about July 8, 2024, at the County of Darke, State of Ohio, Kyle W Harter did, with knowledge of the character of the material or performance involved, create, reproduce, or publish obscene material that had a minor as one of its participants or portrayed observers;

this being a felony of the second degree in violation of Section 2907.321(A)(1) of the Ohio Revised Code (Pandering Obscenity Involving A Minor).

COUNT 2:

On or about July 8, 2024, at the County of Darke, State of Ohio, Kyle W Harter did photograph a minor, to wit Confidential Victim (DOB 10-21-11), who was not the Kyle W Harter's child or ward, in a state of nudity, or create; direct, produce, or transfer any material or performance that shows the said Confidential Victim in a state of nudity; such nudity being a lewd exhibit or graphically focused on the minor's genitals;

this being a felony of the second degree in violation of Section 2907.323(A)(1) of the Ohio Revised Code (Illegal use of Minor in Nudity-Oriented Material or Performance).
